The significant further information/revised plans<sup>6</sup> in relation to the application has/have<sup>6</sup> been furnished to the planning authority, and is/are<sup>6</sup> available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of the authority during its public opening hours. A submission or observation in relation to the further information/revised plans<sup>6</sup> may be made in writing to the planning authority on payment of the prescribed fee, not later than 2 weeks<sup>7</sup> after the receipt of the newspaper notice and site notice by the planning authority.

## GUIDANCE NOTES:

1. Name of Planning Authority to be the heading for the newspaper notice.
2. Delete as appropriate.
3. Insert planning reference number of the application
4. The location, townland or postal address of the land or structure to which the application relates (as may be appropriate).
5. The name of the applicant. (Full applicant name or registered company name is required).
6. Delete as appropriate.
7. Five weeks in the case of a planning application accompanied by an EIS
