Faulty Public Lighting Privacy Notice

1. **Purpose:** Your information is collected to verify reporting of faulty public lighting in Cork City.
2. **Lawful Basis:** The legal basis for the collection of this data is provided for under Article 6 (1) a Consent and Article 6 (1) e Task carried out in the public interest
3. **Information Sharing:** The information you provide may be shared with the following:
 - Staff of DEADSURE
 - Staff of the Contractor engaged by Cork City Council to repair faulty lighting.
 - Staff of Cork City Council's Public Lighting department
4. **Retention:** Your information will be retained until the fault is closed off or until 30 days have passed whichever is the sooner.
5. **Your Data Protection Rights:** You have the right to request access to personal data held about you, obtain confirmation as to whether data concerning you exists, be informed of the content and source of data and check its accuracy.
